

Report regarding a wayleave from UKPower Network, for the Jubilee Field.

Background:

The Jubilee Field Committee of Management (JFCM) has previously received wayleave monies, for services crossing the Field, directly from the service provider.

The JFCM advised a new correspondence address to the provider.

This brought about a matter-of-course audit by UK Power networks on the pole(s).

Findings by UKPower Network:

There is one pole eligible for a wayleave.

A new wayleave be issued for signing and this must be in the name of the Registered Holder of the Land, which is Clavering Parish Council, as Custodian Trustee.

(Note: this was similar to ECC requiring CPC, not the JFCM to sign legal papers on the diversion of the footpath over the field)

Request from the Jubilee Field:

1. That Clavering Parish Council agrees to signing of the wayleave documents and returns the documentation to UKPower Networks.
2. The JFCM have previously been in receipt of these wayleave funds and use them in their budget. It is asked that the monies due continue to be paid to the JFCM by UK PowerNetworks. See additional comments Page 2 of the Wayleave Document.

UK Power Networks have indicated that a letter from the Parish Council naming that JFCM may receive funds is also required.
