

Representative Reports to Clavering Parish Council for the Parish Council Meeting 11th May 2026

33.2 Allotments

Further to the comment made by an allotment holder in the April Meeting, I visited the allotments to see which sign had been removed.

The signs purchased by CPC stating that there is no public access to the allotments are still in place.

The sign which was referred to I believe was actually missing when the new signs were put up.

If wished the parish council could obtain quotes for two signs to state that dogs are not permitted to enter the site.

A note was placed in the April Newsletter reminding parishioners there is no public right of way over the allotment grounds and dogs should not be walked there.

Some holders have requested a skip – it would need to be ascertained what funds are available in the Allotment Reserves for this after the payment of this year's rents. Also safe access needs to be determined.

33.3 Litter Picking 22nd March 2026

This was not formally reported on at the April meeting.

Nine parishioners took part, including two children under the watchful eye of their mother and 15 bags of rubbish were collected on the day.

Concerning the washing of village signs, the person has come forward to identify themselves to me and thanks have been given over.

33.4 Passenger Transport

I have managed to speak with Essex Passenger Transport. They have confirmed that the DART 299 bus through Clavering will continue on contract renewal as before, with passengers collected from their homes; they will not be collected from designated bus stops.
